

2009 - 2010 Breakdown of Expenses

Annual Expenses for Novice and First Year Varsity Rowers

- \$945 Dues of \$105 per month, due September 1 - May 1.
(Monthly dues are reduced to \$55 per month for rowers on scholarship or siblings.)
- \$ 70 Unisuit (Required GAR Uniform)
- \$272 Head of the Hooch in Chattanooga, TN. Cost includes transportation, two nights at the hotel, dinner Friday, lunch Saturday and snacks at the race site. Rowers will need additional money for lunch Friday (bus will stop) and dinner Saturday (in Chattanooga) and lunch Sunday (bus will stop).
- \$68 "States" in Sarasota, FL. Cost includes two nights at the hotel, dinner Friday, lunch Saturday and snacks at the race site. Rowers will need additional money for dinner Saturday (in Sarasota) and lunch Sunday.
- \$72 "Regionals" in Sarasota, FL. Cost includes two nights at the hotel, dinner Friday, lunch Saturday and snacks at the race site. Rowers will need additional money for dinner Saturday (in Sarasota) and lunch Sunday.
- \$1,427 Total annual (9 months) expenses for a novice rower and first year varsity rower.

Annual Expenses for Returning Varsity rowers

- \$945 Due of \$105 per month, September 1 - May 1 (\$55 per month for rowers on scholarship or siblings.)
- \$412 Total for Head of the Hooch, States, and Regionals (see above for detail).
- \$1,357 Total annual (9 months) expenses for a returning varsity rower

Annual Expenses for Middle School Scullers

- \$495 Dues of \$55 per month, due September 1 - May 1.
(\$30 per month for rowers on scholarship or siblings.)
- \$495 Total annual (9 months) expenses for a sculler

OTHER EXPENSES

In addition, some rowers choose to buy GAR jackets (\$110) and duffel bags (\$30) and tech shirts (\$35). An order form for these items is included in the New Rower Packet and will be available on the GAR website, gainesvillearearowing.com. And, almost everyone comes to the year-end banquet - ticket prices to be determined at a later date.

Rowers whose boats qualify for the Youth National Championship Regatta in Cincinnati, Ohio will pay an extra month of dues (June). Travel expenses for the rowers are estimated to be \$300-\$500 each depending on the mode of transportation utilized. All travel expenses for the rowers and the parents are the responsibility of the parents.
