## Tips for this race site

The **regatta site** is easy walking distance from hotel. You can view the races from Ross's Landing Park and the Walnut Street pedestrian bridge.

There are lots of **restaurants** and other activities close by the hotel and regatta site.

No matter how hot it is outside, bring a blanket if you are riding the **charter bus**.

Because this is such a large regatta, it attracts many **vendors**. Of all the regattas GAR attends, the Head of the Hooch has the best selection by far of rowing-related items such as clothing, hats, and jewelry.

## **Directions from Gainesville** (to the hotel)

- 1. Start out on I-75 North. *Drive* **→ 230** *miles on I-75 North*.
- 2. Take Exit 156 off of I-75 North on to I-475 North to Atlanta. Drive → 15 miles on I-475 North. Note: Using I-475 is much shorter than staying on I-75 through Macon, but if you miss the I-475 North exit just stay on I-75 to step 4 below.
- 3. Take ramp off of I-475 North on to I-75 North.

  Drive → 179 miles on I-75 North.
- 4. Take Exit 2 off of I-75 North on to I-24 West to Chattanooga/Nashville. *Drive* → 6.3 miles on I-24 West.
- 5. Take Exit 178 off of I-24 West on to U.S. 27 North to Downtown/Lookout Mountain/Market Street.

  Drive ~ 2.1 miles on U.S. 27 North.



- Take Exit 4C off of U.S. 27 North on to West 4th Street (TN 58 North) to Downtown. Drive ~ 0.1 miles on 4th Street.
- 7. Turn left off of West 4th Street on to Chestnut Street. *Drive* •• 0.2 miles to the hotel parking lot.
